SB 284 Original

Present law provides for definitions.

Proposed law adds the definitions for "infant formula" and "baby food".

Present law prohibits the sale of certain unsafe children's products after Jan. 1, 2002.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and further prohibits on or after Aug. 1, 2017, the sale of infant formula or baby food that is stored in a plastic container, jar, or can that contains bisphenol-A.

Present law provides the criteria for unsafe children's products.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds infant formula or baby food that is stored in a plastic container, jar, or can that contains bisphenol-A to the list of unsafe children's products.

Effective August 1, 2016.
