Abstract: Excepts certain charter schools from the requirement that they employ instructional staff who have at least a baccalaureate degree.

<u>Present law</u> requires charter schools to employ instructional staff who have at least a baccalaureate degree. <u>Proposed law</u> excepts a charter school from this requirement if it offers a teacher credentialing program in conjunction with a postsecondary education institution.

<u>Present law</u> also provides that all <u>present law</u> relative to background checks applicable to the employment of public school personnel also applies to charter school instructional staff. <u>Proposed</u> law retains present law.
