HEALTH SERVICES. Provides for staffing standards at ambulatory surgical centers.
(8/1/16)

AN ACT

To enact R.S. 40:2136(D), relative to staffing standards at ambulatory surgical centers; to provide for regulation restrictions; to provide for staffing patterns; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 40:2136(D) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§2136. Rules; regulations; minimum standards

* * *

D. Notwithstanding any provision of this Chapter to the contrary, no rule, regulation, or minimum standard promulgated pursuant to this Section shall require a staffing pattern for nonsurgical endoscopy procedures performed at an ambulatory surgical center to exceed the staffing pattern for such procedures recommended by the American Society for Gastrointestinal Endoscopy.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective on August 1, 2016; if vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on August 1, 2016, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
