2 To enact R.S. 17:3991(6) relative to charter schools; to prohibit a charter school from 3 requiring disclosure of certain student information; and to provide for related 4 matters. 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: Section 1. R.S. 17:3991(6) is hereby enacted to read as follows: 6 7 §3991. Charter schools; requirements; limitations; renewal; amendment; revocation 8 9 E. 10 (6) Require the parent or legal guardian of any student to disclose 11 medical information or special education needs prior to the student being enrolled in the charter school, unless otherwise specifically required by law. 12 13 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 14 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If 15 16 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval. 17
