SENATE BILL NO. 355

BY SENATOR CORTEZ

SCHOOLS. Requires contracts to comply with local public school board policy. (8/1/16)

AN ACT

To enact R.S. 17:81(A)(7), relative to the powers of local public school boards; to provide for local school board policies and procedures; to provide relative to contracting authority; to require contracts to comply with local public school board policy; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 17:81(A)(7) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§81. General powers of local public school boards

A.

* * *

(7) Any person purporting to enter into any contract on behalf of the school district or schools under the board's jurisdiction, including but not limited to contracts with vendors or contracts of membership in any private or quasi-public entity, shall do so in compliance with policies and procedures adopted by the local public school board.

Present law (R.S. 17:81) provides for the general powers of local public school boards.

Proposed law requires that any person purporting to enter into any contract on behalf of the school district or schools under the board's jurisdiction, including but not limited to contracts with vendors or contracts of membership in any private or quasi-public entity, comply with policies and procedures adopted by the local public school board.

Effective August 1, 2016.
