# CONGRESS: Memorializes congress to take actions necessary to impose term limits on members of the United States House of Representatives and the United States Senate

1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2	To memorialize the Congress of the United States of America to take all actions necessary
3	to impose term limits on members of the United States House of Representatives and
4	the United States Senate.
5	WHEREAS, according to a Gallup poll conducted in 2013, seventy-five percent of
6	adults nationwide support term limits for members of the United States House of
7	Representatives and the United States Senate; and
8	WHEREAS, in the same poll, eighty-two percent of Republicans, seventy-nine
9	percent of independents, and sixty-five percent of Democrats surveyed supported term limits
10	for members of the United States House of Representatives and the United State Senate; and
11	WHEREAS, term limits for members of the United States House of Representatives
12	and the United States Senate has widespread bipartisan support among American adults.
13	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
14	memorialize the Congress of the United States of America to take all actions necessary to
15	impose term limits on members of the United States House of Representatives and the
16	United States Senate.
17	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
18	presiding officers of the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Congress of the
19	United States of America and to each member of the Louisiana congressional delegation.
