HEALTH CARE. Requests the New Orleans East Hospital to become an American Diabetes Association Education Recognition Program.

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2	To urge and request the New Orleans East Hospital to become an American Diabetes
3	Association Education Recognition Program.
4	WHEREAS, New Orleans East, Gentilly and the Lower 9th Ward were all devastated
5	during Hurricane Katrina in 2005, losing most of the areas' residents and medical
6	infrastructure, including the storm-ravaged Methodist Hospital; and
7	WHEREAS, an urgent care clinic was available to residents, but there was no
8	hospital until 2014 when the New Orleans East Hospital, Orleans Parish Hospital Service
9	District A, opened with a mission to provide superior quality health care and educational
10	empowerment to the community; and
11	WHEREAS, a key component to educational empowerment is understanding chronic
12	diseases such as diabetes; and
13	WHEREAS, according to the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention 2014
14	Diabetes Report Card, among adults, about 1.7 million new cases of diabetes are diagnosed
15	each year; and
16	WHEREAS, the CDC has identified several risk factors that contribute to diabetes
17	including increased age, lack of physical activity, a family history of diabetes, certain
18	socioeconomic conditions, obesity, and race and ethnicity; and

WHEREAS, these risk factors are prevalent in the New Orleans East area, but
without appropriate education on the disease, many people may not even know that they
have it and those who have it may not be managing it most appropriately; and
WHEREAS, the American Diabetes Association has a program that allows providers
who meet the national standards of excellence in diabetes education to be recognized as
having attained Education Program Recognition; and
WHEREAS, there are currently thirty-eight providers in Louisiana who have attained
this status, and it would be in the best interest of the New Orleans East Hospital and the
community served by that hospital if it were also an ADA Diabetes Education Recognition
Program.
THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana hereby urges
and requests the New Orleans East Hospital to pursue recognition as an American Diabetes
Association Diabetes Education Program.
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
CEO of the New Orleans East Hospital.
