CORRECTIONS

Provides with respect to parole supervision fees

<u>Present law</u> provides for the committee on parole and provides that persons on parole must pay supervision fees set by the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections. <u>Proposed law</u> changes present law to specify a supervision fee not to exceed \$63, which existed in the law prior to 2012 R.S.
