VOTERS/VOTING

Proposed law allows a voter to receive assistance in voting on election day if the voter produces a current mobility hang tag or license plate issued to them to the commissioner-in-charge.

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. Proposed law allows voters to receive assistance in voting if they provide a current mobility impairment hang tag or license plate to the commissioner-in-charge, expanding what voters can use as proof of disability. This does not represent an expansion of duties for commissioners-in-charge, as they currently certify the need for voting assistance on election day, therefore the proposed legislation has no impact on expenditures.
