EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

The proposed law will create one-time expenditures for the Secretary of State of an indeterminable amount. The Secretary of State estimates the proposed legislation would cost approximately \$20,000 in one-time programming costs related to implementing the changes associated with candidates and ballots. The Secretary of State will contract these expenses to GCR Inc. at a rate of \$100 per hour and an estimated a total of 200 man-hours needed to complete this project. To the extent this project requires fewer man-hours, the project's estimated total expenditures may be less than \$20,000. The Secretary of State anticipates being able to absorb the costs associated with the proposed legislation into the amount of hours built into its FY 17 base budget for the contract with GCR Inc. However, to the extent numerous pieces of legislation are enacted that require GCR Inc.'s services, the Secretary of State may require additional resources.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
