**Abstract:** Requires local governments to pay up to 30% of costs incurred in representing capital defendants.

<u>Present law</u> provides that in order to fund indigent defense services, court costs of \$45 shall be assessed in certain criminal court cases until Aug. 1, 2016 (\$35 shall be collected thereafter).

<u>Present law</u> provides that in criminal cases where a sentence of death has been imposed, the public defender board shall promptly enroll counsel to represent the defendant. Requires the board to adopt rules and retain only such staff counsel or other counsel, who will work under the supervision of the board, as are necessary to provide counsel to represent capital defendants on direct appeal to the Supreme Court of Louisiana and to seek post-conviction relief if appropriate in state and federal court.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and further provides that the local governing authority of the parish or parishes where a judicial district is located shall provide up to 30% of the costs associated with providing representation to capital defendants.
