Provides that the Gulf Fritillary butterfly, also referred to as the passion butterfly, shall be the official state butterfly

Proposed law establishes the Gulf Fritillary butterfly (*Agraulis vanillae*) as the official state butterfly and authorizes its use along with the insignia of the state.
