INSURANCE POLICIES OR SEE FISC NOTE GF EX

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Requires insurance for persons handling explosives (8/1/16).

<u>Present law</u> provides for the requirements of a manufacturer, dealer-distributor, user, blaster, or handler of explosives to obtain a state-issued license.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds to present law the requirement of proof of a \$50 million liability insurance policy to cover damage caused by blast waves, blast wind, fire, fragmentation, secondary fragmentation shockwaves and stress waves as a condition of issuance of a license.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

It is anticipated that this measure will require Louisiana State Police (LSP) to modify its <u>existing LSP Explosive Licensing database</u> in order to track insurance policy information and insurance policy expirations. The department estimates an IT Applications Programmer Analyst can accomplish this additional requirement by working 40 hours at a cost of roughly \$1,300 (40 OT hours x \$32 hourly rate =\$1,280 plus \$19 for medicare expenses). The Legislative Fiscal Office believes that any additional IT work associated with this legislation will be incremental in nature, and that the department can <u>accomplish these tasks utilizing existing resources and budget authority.</u>

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
