Present law provides relative to the La. Public Defender Fund in the state treasury.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the fund is to be comprised of all monies appropriated, donated, or otherwise made available to provide funding for the provisions of <u>present law</u> (La. Public Defender Act).

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds that the legislature annually is to appropriate sufficient funds for the purposes of <u>present law</u> (La. Public Defender Act). <u>Proposed law</u> further provides that funds appropriated pursuant to <u>proposed law</u> are to be distributed by the board among the district public defenders proportionally based upon the number of arrests annually in each judicial district.

<u>Present law</u> provides that monies in the fund are to be appropriated and used solely and exclusively to provide for the implementation of <u>present law</u> (La. Public Defender Act).

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds that not more than 15% of funds appropriated pursuant to <u>proposed law</u> may be used to defray any fees and expenses associated with the administration of the fund.
