Amendments proposed by House Committee on Health and Welfare to Original House Bill
No. 719 by Representative Hodges

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "1431(D)" and before the comma "," insert "and to enact "Children's
3 Code Article 1427(C)"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 9, after "reenacted" and before "to read" insert "and Children's Code Article
6 1427(C) is hereby enacted"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, between lines 10 and 11, insert the following:

9 "Art. 1427. Authority to transport and detain

10 * * *

11 C.(1) In addition to other persons authorized by this Article to transport to
12 a treatment facility a child in whose name an emergency certificate has been issued,
13 any of the following persons may also accompany the child during such
14 transportation:

15 (a) A parent, including a foster parent, subject to the conditions of Paragraph
16 (2) of this Subarticle.

17 (b) A legal guardian.

18 (c) A Department of Children and Family Services case worker.

19 (2) A biological parent of a child in foster care shall only accompany the
20 child if approved by the Department of Children and Family Services.

22 AMENDMENT NO. 4

23 On page 1, at the beginning of line 11, insert "Art."

24 AMENDMENT NO. 5

25 On page 1, delete lines 13 through 19 in their entirety and delete page 2 in its entirety and
26 insert in lieu thereof the following:

27 "D. If the examining physician determines that the provisions of this Article
28 are met, he shall execute an emergency certificate and shall transport or cause to be
29 transported the minor named in the emergency certificate to a treatment facility in
30 accordance with the provisions of Article 1427."
