**Abstract:** Requires results of skills tests of applicants for certain classes of licenses to submitted to the department electronically rather than by certificate.

<u>Present law</u> requires results of skills test certificates for certain classes of driver's licenses to be submitted to the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes <u>present law</u> and instead requires results of skills tests of applicants for Class "A", "B", or "C" driver's licenses to be submitted to the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections electronically.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the department to promulgate rules in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act to implement <u>proposed law</u>.

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Transportation</u>, <u>Highways and</u> Public Works to the original bill:

- 1. Require results of only skills tests for applicants for Class "A", "B", or "C" driver's licenses be submitted to the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections electronically.
- 2. Authorize the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to promulgate rules in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act to implement proposed law.
