<u>Present law</u> requires every vehicle standing or parked on a highway where there are adjacent curbs to stand or park with the right-hand wheels of such vehicle parallel to and within eighteen inches of the right-hand curb.

Present law defines "residence district" as the territory contiguous to a highway not comprising a business district, when the frontage on such a highway for a distance of three hundred feet or more is mainly occupied by dwellings or by dwellings and buildings in use
