<u>Present law</u> defines the term "medical examiner" to mean a person licensed to practice medicine by the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners, a person licensed to practice chiropractic by the Louisiana State Board of Chiropractic Examiners, a person licensed by the Louisiana State Board of Physical Therapy Examiners, or advanced practice registered nurses.

<u>Proposed law</u> modifies <u>present law</u> to include a person licensed to practice medicine in Louisiana or any other state or territory of the United States.

Effective August 1, 2016.
