14	(6)(a) For the purpose of this Paragraph, "lump-sum payment" means a single
15	payment made all at once from any source, in lieu of recurring payments that would
16	be received by an obligor over a period of time.
17	(b)(i) When a payor intends to issue a lump-sum payment in the amount of
18	three hundred dollars or more to an obligor, the payor shall notify the department
19	within fifteen days prior to its issuance of the lump sum payment. Nothing in this
20	Paragraph shall prevent a payor from reporting a lower lump-sum payment at the
21	payor's discretion.
22	(ii) Notice of the lump-sum payment shall be provided in a method approved
23	by the department. The department shall provide information regarding all approved
24	methods on its website.
25	(c) If, after fifteen days from the date the payor notifies the department, the
26	payor has not received any verification from the department as to any withholdings
27	of the lump-sum payment, then the payor may dispense the lump-sum payment in
28	<u>full to the obligor.</u>
29	(d) The provisions of this Paragraph only apply when the department is
30	providing support enforcement services.
31	(e) A payor who complies with the requirements of this Paragraph shall not
32	be subject to the penalties in Subsection K."
