Provides relative to certain entities or organizations receiving capital outlay funding. (8/1/16)

The proposed legislative provides that if an entity or organization has received \$1 M in capital outlay funding for a project that collects a general admission charge, such entity or organization shall designate one day each month where LA residents are exempted from paying the general admission charge.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

The proposed legislation exempts LA residents one day each month from paying admission charges to entities or organizations that received \$1 M in capital outlay funding for a project that collects a general admission charge. However, the fiscal impact on state and local revenues is indeterminable since it will depend on the number of state or local entities or organizations that received \$1 M in capital outlay funding for a project that collects a general admission charge; amount of general admission fees; and the number of residents taking advantage of the free admission monthly.

Note: It is assumed that the proposed legislation is applicable to capital outlay funding provided to entities or organizations in prior fiscal years; and those that may receive funding in subsequent future years.
