## DIGEST 2016 Regular Session

Erdey

Present law authorizes the issuance of various military honor license plates.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the issuance of a military honor license plate to a qualified disabled veteran who has a service-connected disability of 100% as determined by the U.S. Dept. of Veterans Affairs and who is a resident of this state. Provides for the plate to contain the designation "100% DV" and the international symbol of accessibility. Requires issuance of the plate without a fee and without renewal requirements applicable to standard plates. Requires the secretary to establish such rules and regulations as are necessary to implement the provisions of <u>proposed law</u>. Provides for issuance of mobility-impaired hang tags to applicant's for military honor license plates. Provides for the disposition of military honor license plates and hang tags.

Effective August 1, 2016.
