Carter

<u>Present law</u> provides that it is unlawful for any person under 21 years of age to play casino games, gaming devices, or slot machines.

Proposed law retains present law.

SB 394 Original

<u>Present law</u> provides that a person under the age of 21 is not allowed to enter, or be permitted to enter, the designated gaming area of a riverboat, the official gaming establishment, or the designated slot machine gaming area of a pari-mutuel wagering facility that offers live horse racing licensed for operation and regulated under the applicable provisions of <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but makes clear that the prohibition of <u>present law</u> applies to the entire gaming area of an official gaming establishment, but not to the non-gaming areas of the establishment.

Effective August 1, 2016.
