Abstract: Requires the division of administration to establish a baseline average of certain monthly expenditures for each agency and requires the commissioner to approve certain expenditures in excess of the baseline average.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the division of administration to establish a baseline average of monthly expenditures for acquisitions, supplies, and travel using the monthly expenditure amounts for Fiscal Year 2015-2016. Further requires the division to reestablish the baseline average for each agency in Fiscal Year 2019-2020, and every five fiscal years thereafter.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the commissioner of administration to approve any expenditure during the months of May or June for acquisitions, supplies, or travel in excess of the baseline average prior to the expenditure.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
