Abstract: Provides an exemption from the payment of tolls on the Tomey J. Doucet Bridge for a World War II veteran.

<u>Proposed law</u> exempts a World War II veteran from the payment of tolls on the Tomey J. Doucet Bridge when the veteran has purchased an exempt toll tag and presents a certificate of motor vehicle registration, a copy of military records verifying service during World War II and any one of the following as proof of residency: (1) an official La. driver's license; (2) proof of homestead exemption; and (3) a voter registration card.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the Dept. of Transportation and Development to adopt rules and regulations in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act to efficiently implement and enforce the provisions of <u>proposed law</u>.
