PUBLIC CONTRACTS: Provides for an exception for products required as part of an integrated coastal protection project to the prohibition on closed specification of products in the construction of public buildings or projects

1 AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 38:2290, relative to the construction of public buildings or projects; to provide for exceptions to the prohibition on closed specification of a product used in the construction of a public building or project; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 38:2290 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§2290. Closed specification prohibited; exception

A. No architect or engineer, either directly or indirectly, shall submit a closed specification of a product to be used in the construction of a public building or project, unless all products other than the one specified would detract from the utility of the building, or except in those cases where a particular material is required to preserve the historical integrity of the building or the uniform appearance of an existing structure, or is required as part of an integrated coastal protection project as defined in R.S. 49:214.2(11).

B. A closed specification shall not be submitted or authorized when any person or group of persons possess the right to exclusive distribution of the specified product, unless the product is required to expand or extend an existing system presently operating at the facility or site, or if a specified product is required as part

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of an integrated coastal protection project as defined in R.S. 49:214.2(11). However, no such closed specifications shall be allowed until rules have been promulgated by the division of administration after oversight by the Senate and House Committees on Transportation, Highways and Public Works and other appropriate legislative committees.

Abstract: Provides an exception for products required as part of an integrated coastal protection project to the prohibition of closed specification of a product to be used in the construction of a public building or project.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits an architect or engineer from submitting a closed specification of a product to be used in the construction of public buildings or projects unless all products other than the one specified would detract from the utility of the building or projects, or in cases where a particular material is required for historical integrity of the building or the uniform appearance of an existing structure.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and further authorizes an exception for products required as part of an integrated coastal protection project.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits closed specification of a product when a person or group of persons have the right to exclusive distribution of the product except when the product is required to expand or extend an existing system operating on the public facility or site.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but authorizes an exception for products required as part of an integrated coastal protection project.
