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Abstract: Excepts genetic information obtained by health insurers for specific purposes from <u>present law</u> containing various requirements for and restrictions on the use of such information by health insurers.

<u>Present law</u> provides relative to genetic information, including various requirements for and restrictions on the use of such information by health insurers. Also provides for exceptions from <u>proposed law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> additionally provides that the requirements of <u>present law</u> shall not apply to genetic information obtained:

- (1) For treatment, payment, and healthcare operations by an insurer consistent with the federal Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) and its related regulations.
- (2) For maintenance of information by an insurer in accordance with record retention requirements.
