Abstract: Establishes the duration of economic hardship licenses, when related to state tax delinquency, issued by the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles, as a period of two years or until such time as the individual has paid or made payment arrangements.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles from issuing an economic hardship license to a person whose driver's license is suspended and has not been renewed because of delinquent state taxes.

<u>Proposed law</u> modifies <u>present law</u> by requiring the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles to issue an economic hardship license to a person whose driver's license is suspended and has not been renewed because of delinquent state taxes. Specifies that the economic hardship license is valid for a period of two years or until such time as the individual has paid or made payment arrangements relative to his state tax delinquency.
