TOPS. Increases the minimum GPA required for the Performance and Honors Awards. (gov sig)

AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 17:5024(A), relative to the academic requirements for the Taylor
3	Opportunity Program for Students; to increase the minimum cumulative grade point
4	average required for certain awards; to provide for an effective date; and to provide
5	for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 17:5024(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
8	§5024. Academic requirements
9	A.(1) Except as otherwise provided by this Subsection, students shall meet
10	the following minimum grade point average requirements, calculated on a 4.00 scale
11	using only the grades obtained by the student in completing the core curriculum
12	requirements established by this Chapter, for the respective awards:
13	(a) For an Opportunity Award, a minimum cumulative grade point average
14	of 2.50.
15	(b) For a Performance Award, a minimum cumulative grade point average
16	of 3.00 <u>3.25</u> .
17	(c) For an Honors Award, a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.00

1	<u>3.50</u> .
2	(d) For a TOPS-Tech Award, a minimum cumulative grade point average of
3	2.50.
4	(2)(a) For a student who graduated prior to the 2002-2003 school year, the
5	minimum cumulative grade point average shall be calculated by using the grades
6	obtained by the student in completing all classes taken.
7	(b) For a student who graduated prior to the 2007-2008 school year, the
8	minimum cumulative high school grade point average necessary for such students
9	student to be eligible for an initial Performance Award or Honors Award shall be
10	3.50 on a 4.00 scale.
11	(c)(i) For a student who graduated prior to the 2020-2021 school year,
12	the minimum cumulative high school grade point average necessary for such
13	student to be eligible for an initial Opportunity Award shall be 2.50 on a 4.00
14	scale.
15	(ii) For a student who graduated prior to the 2020-2021 school year, the
16	minimum cumulative high school grade point average necessary for such
17	student to be eligible for an initial Performance Award shall be 3.00 on a 4.00
18	<u>scale.</u>
19	(iii) For a student who graduated prior to the 2020-2021 school year, the
20	minimum cumulative high school grade point average necessary for such
21	student to be eligible for an initial Honors Award shall be 3.00 on a 4.00 scale.
22	(3)(a) The calculation of the minimum cumulative grade point average
23	specified in Paragraph (1) of this Subsection shall utilize a five-point scale for grades
24	earned in certain Advanced Placement courses, International Baccalaureate courses,
25	gifted and talented courses, honors courses, articulated courses for college credit, and
26	dual enrollment courses as approved by the Board of Regents and the State Board of
27	Elementary and Secondary Education, which may result in a student earning a
28	cumulative grade point average that exceeds 4.00. For such courses, five quality
29	points shall be assigned to a letter grade of "A", four quality points shall be assigned

1 to a letter grade of "B", three quality points shall be assigned to a letter grade of "C", 2 two quality points shall be assigned to a letter grade of "D", and zero quality points shall be assigned to a letter grade of "F". 3 (b) The provisions of Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph do not apply to 4 5 students who graduated prior to the 2017-2018 school year. 6 7 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 8 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 9 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If 10 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become 11 effective on the day following such approval.

<u>Present law</u> provides for academic requirements for the Taylor Opportunity Program for Students (TOPS) awards. Provides for a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) and ACT score for each award type.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>.

<u>Present law</u> provides that for an Opportunity Award, a minimum GPA of 2.50 is required. Provides that for a Performance Award and an Honors Award, a minimum GPA of 3.00 is required.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> for any student who graduates prior to the 2020-2021 school year.

For a student who graduates in the 2020-2021 school year or later, <u>proposed law</u> retains the 2.50 GPA requirement for the Opportunity Award, but requires a minimum GPA of 3.25 for a Performance Award, and 3.50 for an Honors Award.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
