**HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS**

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice to  
Original House Bill No. 546 by Representative Hunter

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 4, after "penalties;" and before "to" insert "to provide for restitution;"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, delete lines 10 through 12 in their entirety and add the following:

5 "B. Any person who intentionally claims more than one homestead  
6 exemption shall be fined not more than five hundred dollars, imprisoned for not more  
7 than six months, or both.

8 C. In addition to the penalties provided in Subsection B of this Section, a  
9 person convicted of a violation of this Section shall be ordered to make full  
10 restitution to the state or local governmental subdivision which has suffered a  
11 financial loss as a result of the offense. If a person ordered to make restitution  
12 pursuant to this Section is found to be indigent and therefore unable to make  
13 restitution in full at the time of conviction, the court shall order a periodic payment  
14 plan consistent with the person's financial ability."

15 AMENDMENT NO. 3

16 On page 1, at the beginning of line 13, change "C." to "D."
