20 A. From revenues of the Assessment Districts in East Feliciana and West Feliciana parishes, the assessor in each of these parishes may receive an automobile 21 22 expense allowance equal to fifteen percent of his annual salary if the allowance is 23 approved by a majority of the voters of the parish voting in an election held for that 24 purpose and provided that the assessor maintains three hundred thousand dollars of 25 automobile insurance per accident for bodily injury and one hundred thousand 26 dollars of automobile insurance per accident for property damage. The expense allowance shall come from existing funds of the assessment district and at no 27 28 additional expense to the state or local governing authority.

B. The proposition seeking approval of the electors for the assessor to
 receive an automobile expense allowance shall be included on the ballot of the
 statewide election to be held on November 8, 2016.

Section 2. The official ballot to be used at the election which includes the proposition for the electors to authorize an automobile expenses allowance for the assessor in East Feliciana and West Feliciana Parishes, which the electors of each of these parishes shall be permitted to vote YES or NO, shall read as follows: Do you support authorizing the parish assessor to receive an automobile expense allowance equal to fifteen percent of the assessor's annual compensation, which automobile expense allowance shall be part of the assessor's annual compensation and shall be paid from existing funds in the assessor's office?"
