Subject: Increases Penalties for Illegal Carrying of Firearms

WEAPONS/FIREARMS OR INCREASE GF EX See Note
Increases penalties for possession of a firearm during the commission of a crime of violence

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<u>Present law provides penalties of a \$500 fine, imprisonment of up to 6 months, or both for the crime of illegal carrying of weapons. Present law provides additional penalties of a minimum fine of \$2,000 and imprisonment of between 1 and 2 years if the firearm is used while committing a crime of violence as currently outlined in LA R.S. 14:2(B). <u>Proposed law</u> alters prison sentences for persons using an illegal weapon while committing a crime of violence from a minimum of 2 years, but not more than 5 years.</u>

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Proposed law will increase SGF expenditures by an indeterminable amount to the extent any offenders are convicted under LA R.S. 14:95(B)(2). The <u>proposed law</u> increases penalties for persons convicted of illegally carrying weapons while committing a crime of violence as defined in LA R.S. 14:2(B). <u>Proposed law</u> increases the minimum sentence by 1 year, <u>from</u> 1 year <u>to</u> 2 years. Furthermore, proposed law increases the maximum sentence by 3 years, <u>from</u> 2 years <u>to</u> 5 years. The sentence would be served consecutively with any sentence imposed for committing a crime of violence as defined in LA R.S. 14:2(B). The expenditure increase would occur no sooner than FY 18 as a 1 year minimum sentence exists in <u>present law</u>.

SGF expenditures will increase by \$51.68 per offender per day if offenders are housed in state facilities and by \$24.39 for state offenders housed in local facilities. Offenders sentenced to the custody of the Dept. of Public Safety & Corrections for one year would increase SGF expenditures by \$18,863 (\$51.68 per day * 365 days) if housed in a state facility and \$8,902 (\$24.39 per day * 365 days) if housed in local facilities. Approximately 50% of state offenders are housed in state facilities and approximately 50% of state offenders are housed in local facilities.

To the extent an offender serves the maximum of 5 years, the cost in a state facility would be \$94,315 (1 offender * \$18,863 per year * 5 years) or \$44,510 (1 offender * \$8,902 per year * 5 years) if a state offender is housed in a local facility.

Note: DPS reports there are currently no offenders incarcerated under LA R.S. 14:95(B)(2).

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
