Abstract: Authorizes an automobile expense allowance for the assessor in Lafayette Parish not to exceed 15% of the assessor's salary to be paid from existing funds of the assessor's office.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes an automobile expense allowance for the assessor in Webster Parish. The amount of the allowance is equal to 15% of the assessor's annual salary and shall be payable out of existing funds of the assessor's office, provided the assessor maintains \$300,000 of automobile insurance per accident for bodily injury and \$100,000 of automobile insurance per accident for property damage.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> as it relates to the assessor in Webster Parish but adds authorization for the assessor in Lafayette Parish to have an automobile expense allowance as provided for in <u>present</u> and <u>proposed law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds a limitation for the assessors in both Webster and Lafayette parishes that the amount of the expense allowance shall not exceed 15% of the assessor's annual salary and that the expense allowance shall be funded by the assessor at no additional expense to the state or local governing authority.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Ways and Means to the original bill:

1. Add a limitation on the amount of the automobile expense allowance for the assessors in Webster and Lafayette parishes to not exceed 15% of the assessor's annual salary.
