9 the failure of a fund to comply with the approved corrective action plan.

10(b) The court may issue an injunction to restrain the fund and its officers,11agents, directors, or employees from transacting any insurance business or disposing12of property until further action by the court. The court may issue any other such13injunction as it deems necessary to prevent interference with the proceedings or with14the ability of the commissioner to conduct business; as well as any injunction sought15to protect any assets that are in the control of the commissioner.16(3)"

19	"E. The distribution of general assets from the estate of a fund shall be
20	prioritized as follows:
21	(1) The commissioner's costs and expenses of administration.
22	(2) Any amounts payable to the Louisiana Workers' Compensation Second
23	Injury Fund, when the commissioner makes a determination that the payment is in
24	the best interest of the estate of the fund.
25	(3) Payment of claims by injured workers, beneficiaries, and insureds arising
26	from and within the coverage of agreements or evidences of coverage issued by the
27	fund, up to the policy limits.
28	(4) Payment of claims by the federal government other than those claims
29	otherwise prioritized within this Subsection.
30	(5)(a) Payment of compensation owed to employees of the fund, excluding
31	officers, for services rendered within three months prior to the commencement of a
32	proceeding against the fund, up to two thousand five hundred dollars for each
33	employee.
34	(b) Payment to employees shall occur as soon as practicable after the
35	proceeding has commenced provided that the commissioner has reserved the funds
36	sufficient for the payment of claims as prioritized pursuant to this Subsection.
37	(6) Payment of claims for unearned premiums or other premium refunds and
38	claims of general creditors, including claims of any ceding and assuming company
39	in their capacity as such.
40	(7) Payment of all other claims.
