12	(5) "Proprietary school", hereinafter referred to as "school", means any
13	business enterprise operated for a profit or on a nonprofit basis which maintains a
14	place of business within this state, or which sells or offers for sale any course of
15	instruction in this state, either by correspondence using the mails or by any other

means of communication, or by personal solicitation, and which offers or maintains

a course or courses of instruction or study, or at which place of business such a

course or courses of instruction or study is available through classroom or Internet 1 2 instruction, or both, to a person or persons for the purpose of training or preparing 3 such person for a field of endeavor in a business, trade, technical, or industrial 4 occupation, except as hereinafter excluded. The definition of a proprietary school shall not include: 5 6 (p) A school or business enterprise which provides students with 7 8 advanced training techniques for police and service dogs. 9
