<u>Present law</u> provides that provisions concerning the authority and funding of the insurance fraud investigation unit in the Department of Public Safety and Corrections will be null, void, and unenforceable on July 1, 2016.

Proposed law extends these provisions until July 1, 2018.

Effective date of above proposed law is July 1, 2016.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the Sledge Jeansonne Louisiana Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, which allows the attorney general to institute civil proceedings against any person who commits certain fraudulent insurance acts, terminates August 1, 2016.

Proposed law extends these provisions until August 1, 2018.

Effective date of above proposed law is August 1, 2016.
