2	To amend and reenact R.S. 22:1062(D)(1), relative to certificates of coverage provided by

7	Section 1. R.S. 22:1062(D)(1) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
8	§1062. Increased portability through limitation on preexisting condition exclusions

10	D.(1) A group health plan, and a health insurance issuer offering group
11	health insurance coverage, shall provide send the certification of the period of
12	creditable coverage no more than twenty days after such certification is requested by
13	an individual who ceases to be covered under the issuer's policy or plan:
14	(a) At the time an individual ceases to be covered under the plan or
15	otherwise becomes covered under a COBRA continuation provision.
16	(b) In the case of an individual becoming covered under such a provision,
17	at the time the individual ceases to be covered under such provision.
18	(c) On the request on behalf of an individual made not later than twenty-four
19	months after the date of cessation of the coverage described in Subparagraph (a) or
20	(b) of this Paragraph, whichever is later. The certification under Subparagraph (a)

Abstract: Provides that certificates of creditable coverage provided by group health plans and certain health insurance issuers shall be sent within 20 days of request.

<u>Present law</u> requires a group health plan, and a health insurance issuer offering group health coverage, to provide certification of the period of creditable coverage at various times, including when an individual ceases to be covered under the plan or under a COBRA (Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act) continuation provision, pursuant to the federal HIPAA (Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act) law.

<u>Proposed law</u> instead requires that such certification of creditable coverage be sent no more than 20 days after it is requested by an individual who ceases to be covered under the issuer's policy or plan.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Insurance</u> to the original bill:

1. Delete requirement that certificates of creditable coverage be provided when requested. Instead require that such certificates be sent within 20 days of request.

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Delete <u>present law</u> providing for provision of certificates of creditable coverage at various times pursuant to the federal HIPAA law.
