

HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

2016 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Civil Law and Procedure to Original House Bill No. 282 by Representative Connick

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, delete line 2 in its entirety and insert "To amend and reenact Civil Code Articles 3492 and 3493.10,"

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, line 4, after "actions;" delete the remainder of the line and at the beginning of line 5, delete "actions;" and insert "to provide a one-year prescriptive period applicable to delictual actions against the state, state agencies, and political subdivisions;"

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 1, line 7, change "Article 3493.10 is" to "Articles 3492 and 3493.10 are"

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 1, between lines 8 and 9, insert the following:

"Art. 3492. Delictual actions; one-year prescription
Delictual actions against the state, a state agency, or a political subdivision are subject to a liberative prescription of one year. This prescription commences to run from the day injury or damage is sustained. It does not run against minors or interdicts in actions involving permanent disability and brought pursuant to the Louisiana Products Liability Act or state law governing product liability actions in effect at the time of the injury or damage.

AMENDMENT NO. 5

On page 1, at the beginning of line 10, delete "Delictual" and insert "Except as provided in Article 3492, delictual"

AMENDMENT NO. 6

On page 1, delete line 17 in its entirety

AMENDMENT NO. 7

On page 1, at the beginning of line 18, change "Section 3." to "Section 2."
