Thompson

<u>Present law</u> authorizes an automobile expense allowance for the assessor in Webster Parish. The allowance is equal to 15% of the assessor's annual salary and payable out of existing funds of the assessor's office, provided the assessor maintains \$300,000 of automobile insurance per accident for bodily injury and \$100,000 of automobile insurance per accident for property damage.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> as it relates to the assessor in Webster Parish but adds authorization for the assessors in Madison and St. Bernard parishes to have an equivalent automobile expense allowance as provided for in <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds a limitation that the expense allowance shall be funded by the assessor at no additional expense to the state or local governing authority.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
