Requires that student identification cards issued by public postsecondary education institutions meet certain requirements

<u>Proposed law</u> requires each public postsecondary management board to ensure that a student identification card issued by a public postsecondary education institution under its jurisdiction contains the elements required for voting purposes.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

The proposed legislation will result in an indeterminable increase in expenditures as a result of requiring that student identification cards contain each required element for a generally recognized picture identification card (photo and signature of applicant). At this time it is unknown how each institution handles the student identification card process and what each institution includes on the identification card. To the extent institutions have to add signatures, photos or both on the identification card, institutions will incur costs associated with card redesign and computer and other information technology modifications.

It is possible that some institutions issue identification cards with just a name and student identification numbers through the registration process which can be done entirely online. In the event institutions have to capture signatures and photos in person, institutions may require additional staffing for this process. The extent of such increases cannot be determined at this time but will depend upon the resources of the individual institution.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
