Amendments proposed by House Committee on Health and Welfare to Original House Bill No. 1019 by Representative Edmonds

## 1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- 2 On page 1, at the beginning of line 12, change "(1)" to "(1)(a)"
- 3 AMENDMENT NO. 2
- 4 On page 1, between lines 12 and 13, insert the following:
- 5 "(b)(i) For purposes of this Section, "abortion" shall not include an abortion
  6 performed when the pregnancy is diagnosed as medically futile.
- (ii) For purposes of this Subparagraph, "medically futile" means that, in reasonable medical judgement, the unborn child has a profound and irremediable congenital or chromosomal anomaly that is incompatible with sustaining life after birth. This diagnosis must be a medical judgment that would be made by a reasonably prudent physician who is knowledgeable about the case and the treatment possibilities with respect to the medical conditions involved."
