Abstract: Increases the maximum \$75 notary examination fee to a fixed \$100 fee, and changes the maximum \$100 charge for the notary exam study materials to a fixed \$100 charge.

Present law requires the secretary of state to develop and administer a uniform statewide notarial exam and authorizes a fee not to exceed \$75 for each examinee taking the examination.

Proposed law retains present law and increases the maximum \$75 fee to a fixed \$100 fee.

Present law requires the secretary of state to publish and make available to the public a document containing the material and sources from which examination questions are devised and charge a fee for the actual cost not to exceed \$100.

Proposed law retains present law and changes the maximum \$100 charge to a fixed \$100 charge.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
