FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS: Establishes an application fee for a new marijuana pharmacy permit and limits eligibility for the permit

DIGEST

<u>Present law</u> establishes the schedule of minimum amounts for fees to be collected by the La. Board of Pharmacy.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds a new medical marijuana pharmacy permit application fee with a minimum amount of \$5000.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits a current member of the La. Board of Pharmacy or his immediate family from applying for a new medical marijuana permit. Further prohibits a person who was a member of the La. Board of Pharmacy or his immediate family from applying for a new medical marijuana permit within two years of the last day of his term on the board.

(Adds R.S. 37:1184(3)(k))

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

- 1. Prohibit a current member of the La. Board of Pharmacy or his immediate family from applying for a new marijuana permit.
- 2. Prohibit a person who was a member of the La. Board of Pharmacy or his immediate family from applying for a new marijuana permit within two years of the last day of his term on the board.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

<u>Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Health and Welfare to the</u> reengrossed bill

1. Clarifies that the new pharmacy permit applies only to medical marijuana.
