15 municipalities provided for in Subsection B of this Section"16 AMENDMENT NO. 517 On page 3, delete lines 27 through 29 in their entirety and on page 4, delete lines 1 through
18 8 in their entirety, and insert the following:19 "(b) If the results of the inspection required by this Section or any other
20 inspection show an imminent danger to human health the secretary of the
21 Department of Health and Hospitals shall appoint a certified operator of the system
22 who shall immediately consult with the chief executive of the entity that owns the
23 water system to determine the appropriate action to take to ensure the safety of the
24 drinking water. If the appointed certified operator is unable to timely consult with
25 such chief executive, the appointed certified operator shall take any action necessary
26 to ensure the safety of the drinking water and notify the executive and the secretary
