Amendments proposed by House Committee on Health and Welfare to Original House Bill No. 606 by Representative Hoffmann

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, line 5, delete "either of"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 2, between lines 9 and 10, insert the following:

5 "(c) An abortion performed when the pregnancy is diagnosed as medically
6 futile. For purposes of this Subparagraph, "medically futile" means that, in
7 reasonable medical judgment, the unborn child has a profound and irremediable
8 congenital or chromosomal anomaly that is incompatible with sustaining life after
9 birth. This diagnosis must be a medical judgment that would be made by a
10 reasonably prudent physician who is knowledgeable about the case and the treatment
11 possibilities with respect to the medical conditions involved."
