**Abstract:** Prohibits sex offenders from working as door-to-door salesmen.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits sex offenders from seeking employment where they operate any bus, taxicab, or limousine for hire, engage in employment as a service worker who goes into a residence to provide any type of service, or operate any carnival or amusement ride (if the victim was a minor child).

<u>Present law</u> further provides for criminal penalties including a fine of not more than \$10,000 and imprisonment for five to 10 years at hard labor, with three years to be served without benefit of probation, parole, or suspension of sentence.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and also prohibits sex offenders from working as door-to-door solicitors.
