## DIGEST 2016 Regular Session

Appel

<u>Present law</u> establishes the Public Bid Law and provides that all public work exceeding the contract limit provided for in present law shall be let out for bid.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits political subdivision from enacting an ordinance mandating local or other preferential hiring requirements not provided for in <u>present law</u>. Further provides that such prohibition will not include any ordinance requiring a bidder or contractor to have certain policies or practices related to discrimination.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that any ordinance in violation with <u>proposed law</u> on its effective date or adopted thereafter shall be deemed preempted by <u>proposed law</u> and shall be null and void.
