**Abstract:** Creates the "Louisiana The Energy State" special prestige license plate. Provides for fees, distribution of fees, issuance, creation, and design of the license plate and promulgation of rules.

Proposed law requires the secretary of the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to issue special prestige license plates to be known as the "Louisiana The Energy State" license plate.

Proposed law restricts use of the "Louisiana The Energy State" license plate to passenger cars, pickup trucks, recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.

Proposed law authorizes the secretary to work in conjunction with the Louisiana Oil and Gas Association to select the color and design of the plate.

Proposed law specifies that the license plate be issued, upon application, to any citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

Proposed law requires the department to collect an annual royalty fee of \$25 for each plate issued and specifies that such fees be collected by the department and forwarded to the treasurer for deposit into the Oilfield Site Restoration Fund.

Proposed law requires the department to collect a handling fee of \$3.50 for each plate, to be retained by the department to offset a portion of administrative costs.

Proposed law requires the secretary to adopt rules and regulations to implement the provisions provided in proposed law.
