Abstract: Provides a child support guideline schedule based on current economic and tax data.

<u>Present law</u> provides a child support guideline schedule which is based on economic estimates of child-rearing expenditures as a portion of household consumption.

<u>Proposed law</u> amends <u>present law</u> to incorporate the most recent economic estimates of child-rearing expenditures as a portion of household consumption.

<u>Present law</u> provides monthly basic child support obligations for combined adjusted monthly gross incomes beginning with \$0 per month.

 $\underline{\text{Proposed law}}$ amends the monthly basic child support obligations and utilizes \$0 - \$950 as the minimum adjusted monthly gross income.

<u>Present law</u> provides a ceiling of \$30,000 for combined adjusted monthly gross income when calculating the basic child support obligation.

<u>Proposed law</u> amends <u>present law</u> by raising the ceiling <u>from</u> \$30,000 <u>to</u> \$40,000 for combined adjusted monthly gross income when calculating the basic child support obligation.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Changes the minimum amount utilized for monthly basic child support obligations <u>from</u> \$950 to \$0-\$950.
