<u>Proposed law</u> provides that no unclassified employee in the executive branch will receive any pay increases for a period starting on the gubernatorial election day and ending on inauguration day without the approval of the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the state Civil Service Commission will adopt the same or substantially similar rule for classified employees barring some exceptions.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
