Provides relative to the powers and authority of the Louisiana State Board of Architectural Examiners

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the LA State Board of Architectural Examiners (Board) to collect certain fees. <u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the Board to issue certificates of authority (COAs); to charge a fee to any corporation, professional architectural corporation any architectural-engineering corporation, or any partnership, limited liability partnership, limited liability company, association, sole proprietorship, or other entity seeking to obtain a COA to practice in Louisiana, unless exempted by the Board; limits the COA fee to no more than \$300; retains <u>present law</u> to the extent that it stipulates that the Board may not increase the fee for issuing a license by more than \$30 during a 3-year period and limits fee increases by the same stipulation relative to COA; requires the annual renewal of COA and limits said renewal fee to no more than \$300; requires the Board to issue a renewal certificate upon payment of said renewal fee; regulates delinquency payments regarding license renewals and COAs; permits assessing a delinquency fee when the annual renewal fee is not paid after June of the fee year; limits the delinquency fee to no more than \$300 and clarifies that the fee shall be paid in addition to the annual renewal fee.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. <u>Proposed law</u> provides relative to certain fees established by the Board.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

<u>Proposed law</u> is projected to increase SGR revenues in the LA State Board of Architectural Examiners. According to the Board, the intent is to increase the current fee by \$25 in state FY 18, which would result in a total revenue increase of approximately \$75,000.

In FY 15, the Board collected \$56,350 in initial registration, renewals, and delinquencies from 417 in-state and 631 out-ofstate architectural firms practicing in Louisiana. The current fee for registration, renewal, and delinquency is \$50. Proposed law authorizes the Board to charge all architectural firms a fee of no more than \$300 for issuing certificates of authority, for renewals, and for delinquency fees. The Board states that it intends to increase the fee from \$50 to \$75 dollars for in-state firms and from \$50 to \$150 for out-of-state firms, and it projects revenues of \$10,425 for in-state firms and \$64,600 for outof-state firms for a total of \$75,025 in FY 18. The FY 18 estimate includes assumptions made by the Board regarding revenue gained by collecting fees from 20 in-state and 10 out-of-state firms that had previously been unregistered yet that were assumed to be practicing in Louisiana. The Board expects the number of architectural firms practicing in Louisiana to increase at 2% annually after FY 18.

<u>NOTE</u>: For illustrative purposes, if the board raised the fee to the maximum of \$300 allowed under <u>proposed law</u> for all firms rather than from \$50 to \$75 as suggested for in-state firms and \$50 to \$150 as suggested for out-of-state firms, the SGR increase would total \$271,000 in FY 18, and SGR is assumed to increase as per a 2% increase in the number of boards licensed annually.
